She is also the author of *Practicing Christian Doctrine: An Introduction to Thinking and Living Theologically*, *God the Spirit: Introducing Pneumatology in Wesleyan and Ecumenical Perspective*, and *The Marks of His Wounds: Resurrection Doctrine and Gender Politics*.
