Coates can comment on the Democratic presidential candidates (Hillary Clinton, Bernie Sanders and Martin Oâ€™Malley) and the Democratic Party platform for the 2016 election. He is the author of the 2014 book, *America in the Shadow of Empires*, which calls for a renewed national conversation about the nature of U.S. foreign policy and its domestic consequences. As in those imperial and global powers before ours, he says, the pursuit of foreign dominance ultimately erodes the strength of the domestic economy. Coates is the author of numerous books, articles and blog posts on politics, history and economics. His books include *Answering Back: Liberal Responses to Conservative Arguments* and *Making the Progressive Case: Towards a Stronger U.S. Economy*.
