Prof. Sherry L. Grace holds her primary appointment as Full Professor in the Faculty of Health at York University. She is also Director of Research at the Cardiovascular Rehabilitation & Prevention Program – GoodLife Fitness Unit of the University Health Network.

Her research interests center on cardiovascular rehabilitation access and care. She has published over 150 peer-reviewed papers. She was recognized with a Canadian Association of Cardiac Rehabilitation Leadership award for her work in Knowledge Translation in 2012.

Dr. Grace led the development of the pan-Canadian quality indicators for cardiac rehabilitation and secondary prevention. She has also been instrumental in the development of the International Council on Cardiovascular Prevention and Rehabilitation, serving on the Executive Board.
