Biography

As associate vice president for research, social sciences and humanities, Antonucci supports the scholarly and creative activities of faculty in the social sciences and humanities by developing new initiatives, leading task forces and addressing policy issues. Since joining the Office of the Vice President for Research in 2009, Antonucci has developed and led the Social Science Annual Institute, which provides seed funding to support up to two projects each year that reflect innovative directions in the social sciences. She also launched Society 2030, a three-year program that brings together university and industry representatives to identify the key social and economic trends that will shape the future, and to develop a “roadmap” to guide planning and policy, as well as further research.
