Drew University of Medicine and Science, where she oversaw activities and services provided by LA County-funded programs. As a consultant with various HIV/AIDS organizations, she also provided direct mental health services to HIV-infected individuals and their families.

Garcia-Sanda is bilingual in English and Spanish and has a special affinity for working with women, high-risk youth and minority populations. She is a licensed clinical social worker and maintains a private psychotherapy practice in Glendale, California.
