Dr. Mary-Kate Lizotte is an expert in public opinion and the origins and implications of gender differences or "gender gaps."

Biography

Dr. Lizotte earned her Ph.D. in Political Science from Stony Brook University. Her research interests include political behavior and gender and public opinion. Much of her work is concerned with the origins and implications of gender differences in public opinion, often referred to as "gender gaps." In addition to her work on public opinion, she also has published research on the gender gap in voting, political knowledge, and party identification. Her work has been published in edited volumes as well as *Politics & Gender*; *Journal of Women, Politics & Policy*; *The Social Science Journal*; and *Journal of Conflict Resolution*. She teaches undergraduate courses on American government, Congress and the Presidency, research methods, and Public Policy Analysis.
