Sohlberg's research focuses on the development and evaluation of tools and therapies to assist individuals with acquired brain injuries optimally re-integrate into their communities. Sohlberg has published numerous articles, chapters, and manuals on managing cognitive impairments following acquired brain injury and is co-author of three leading textbooks in the field. She has been funded on a number of federal projects supporting the development and evaluation of assistive technology to deliver cognitive rehabilitation, and to help individuals with cognitive impairment increase independence and meaningful function.
