Professor Alan Walker is currently Director of MOPACT (Mobilising the potential of active ageing in Europe (<http://www.mopact.group.shef.ac.uk>). He is also Professor of Social Policy and Social Gerontology at the University of Sheffield, UK. Previously he directed the New Dynamics of Ageing Programme (<http://www.newdynamics.group.shef.ac.uk>), INNOVAGE Project (<http://www.innovage.group.shef.ac.uk>), The Growing Older Programme (<http://www.shef.ac.uk/uni/projects/gop/index.htm>), European Research Area in Ageing (<http://www.shef.ac.uk/era-age/>) and FUTURAGE (<http://www.futurage.group.shef.ac.uk>).

He is co-founder and Chair of the European Foundation on Social Quality. He was a member of the Technical Committee responsible for drafting the Revised UN Plan of Action on Ageing. Previously he chaired the European Commission's Observatory on Ageing and Older People. He has been researching and writing on aspects of ageing and social policy for 40 years. Recent books include The New Science of Ageing, The Political Economy of Ageing and Later Life, Active Ageing in Asia and Social Quality, From Theory to Indicators. He has held visiting Chairs in Canada, China, Israel and Japan. As well as being a scientist Alan Walker is an active participant in older people's organisations as patron of the UK National Pensioners' Convention and the Greater London Forum for Older People. He also chaired the Sheffield Fairness Commission 2012-13.
